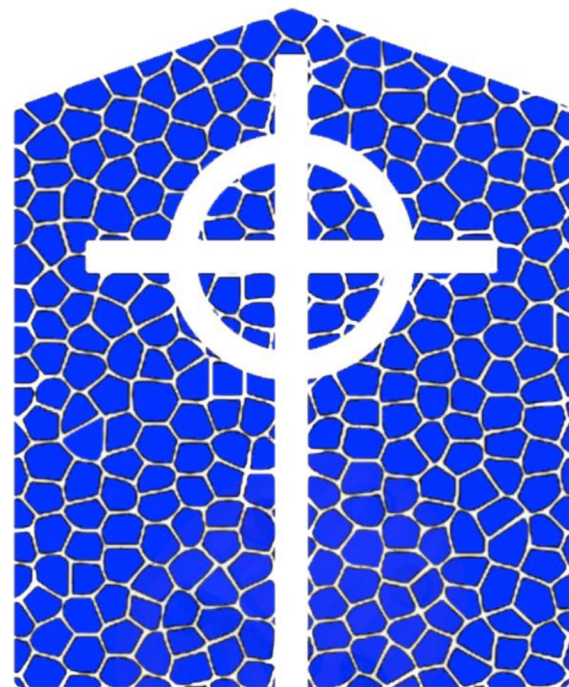

Old Testament Lesson Haggai 1:15b-2:9

<sup>15</sup> on the twenty-fourth day of the month, in the sixth month. In the second year of King Darius, **2** <sup>1</sup> in the seventh month, on the twenty-first day of the month, the word of the LORD came by the prophet Haggai, saying: <sup>2</sup> "Speak now to Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and to the remnant of the people, and say: <sup>3</sup> Who is left among you who saw this house in its former glory? How does it look to you now?
