

The Rev Dr Barry Davies, (aka "Pastor Barry" by the congregation he served in Stone Mountain), was born in England in May, 1929. His first church "position" was as a choirboy at the age of 9, which is when he took piano lessons (and hated to practice). Age 14 started to take organ lessons (and loved it). University at 18 (did not enjoy) was followed by post-grad studies in teaching music, English literature and French (which now largely forgotten through lack of practice). Taught high school (did not enjoy) until emigrating with wife and the beginning of a truly wonderful family to Jamaica in 1954.

The next 22 years in Jamaica saw continued teaching in colleges and university levels, several organ students, training of choirs, and being appointed as Director of the Jamaica School of Music (all quite enjoyed). At the same time, however, was expanding my work into a 2nd career, through regular radio and television productions, live theatre musicals, and opera (all greatly enjoyed)

My family and I moved to do somewhat similar, and for us a very rewarding 3 year work contract in Nassau. It was during this time that a call to the ministry returned to me. So now the need to find a Seminary found us relocating to the U.S.A. This was to become my 3rd career; the one I felt called to as a teenager. I was now 50. So I became a student at Columbia Seminary and doing all the necessary subjects (some of which were extremely painful, but others greatly enjoyed). That wasn't the end of Seminary days, however, because I was then recruited and became a professor co-teaching pastoral care where there were large classes, plus being organist, music advisor to students as they prepared their chapel services, choir director and producer of a wide variety of "speciality" services and operas suitable for church use. I was in the first stage of heaven.

More "heaven" was to come. After retiring from the seminary at nearly 70, I did what I felt was my truest call – to be a pastor in a church setting. There I was given "carte blanche"

to pastor in whatever way I felt suitable and needed, and my old theater days also returned. I was in "pig heaven". I was 86 or so when I retired. Until Covid struck I helped neighbouring churches with music, and deputized as their organist as needed (most rewarding).
