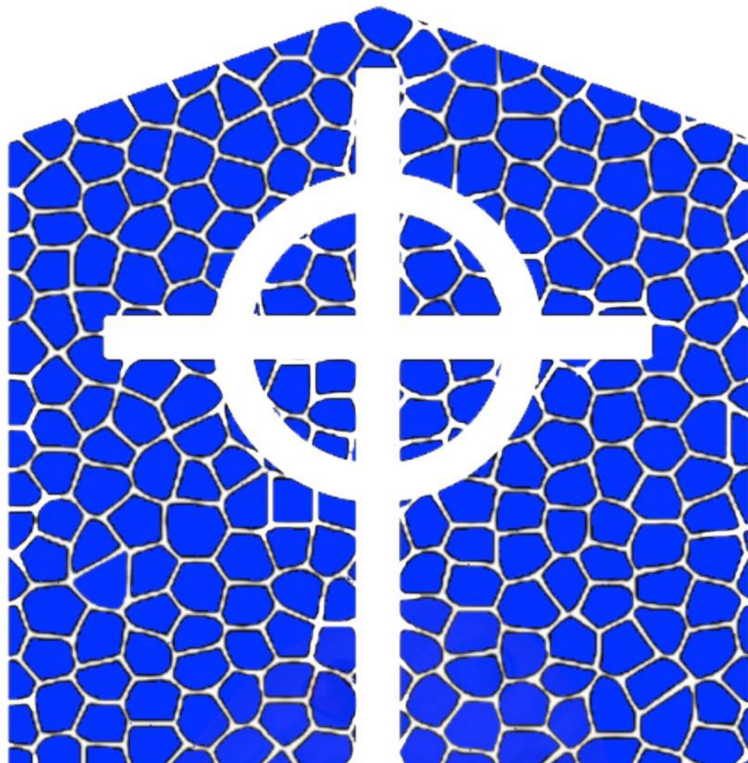

Confession and Lament  
We believe in Jesus, fully human and fully divine. We celebrate the divinity of Christ, but we may often forget that Jesus was human, too. We share humanity with Jesus, and yet we are slow to participate in the story. We witness his baptism but forget the power of baptism in our life as a community. We witness him calling disciples but fail to hear him calling us to action. We witness him healing those in need but forsake those who need us. And so we pray for transformation, saying together:  
**God among us, forgive us when we assume you are far from us and when we fail to recognize our part in your ongoing ministry. We lament that so many feel forsaken. We grieve for all the wounds not healed, actions not taken, and calls not answered. Teach us to participate in your mission in the world, to remember our baptism, hear the call on our lives, and help those who are sent our way. Transform us, so that we may be more like Christ. Amen.**

God is among us! We have been baptized into Christ, who is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. In Christ, we are forgiven. **Amen!**
